STATEMENT EN71-3 Safety for toys compliance LX-101 INKS

Toy safety is the practice of ensuring that toys, especially those made for children, are safe. The EN 71 Toy Safety Standard has been harmonized by the EC as the default standard which toys must meet.

Part 3 of EN 71 contains specifications for migration of certain elements from coatings of paint, varnish, lacquer, printing ink and similar coatings.

On the basis of each raw materials manufacturer's information, we confirmed that hazardous chemical substances in inks and pigments were less than maximum allowable value. The in EN-71-3 mentioned substances are not detectable in the inks.

Mimaki Europe B.V. certifies that the following ink products: LX101-Y-60, LX101-M-60, LX101-C-60, LX101-K-60, LX101-G-60, LX101OR-60 and LX101-W-60 do not intentionally contain metal substances (Sb, As, BA, Cd, Cr, PB, Hg and Se) listed in EN71-3 regulation.
